West Nusa Tenggara (NTB)



Lombok is an island in Indonesia that can be found to the east of Bali and to the west of Sumbawa. It is part of the Lesser Sunda Island chain and is famous for its beautiful beaches and excellent surfing spots, such as Kuta and Banko Banko in the southern part of Lombok. The Gili Islands, which include Gili Trawangan, Gili Air, and Gili Meno, are car-free and located off the western coast of Lombok. These islands offer more stunning beaches, amazing diving and snorkeling sites, as well as a facility for hatching sea turtles.



The nickname "Lombok Island as the Island of a Thousand Mosques" has a meaningful origin, rather than being a random designation. This history helps to explain why Lombok Island is known as the Island of a Thousand Mosques when engaging with tourists or locals in West Nusa Tenggara (NTB) Province. In the 1970s, the Director General of Islamic Guidance at the Ministry of Religion, Mr. Effendi Zarkasih, visited Lombok Island and was impressed by its more than 1,000 mosques, located in both urban and remote areas, ranging from grand to modest structures. This led him to dub the island as the "Island of a Thousand Mosques" as a way to highlight the strong presence of Islam and the rich Islamic heritage on Lombok. The nickname has since stuck and is now widely used to describe the island, attracting visitors who are interested in exploring its religious and cultural significance.

Day 01: Lombok International Airport

Our team will meet you at the airport and then proceed with the Sasak tour program. The tour starts with a visit to Sade Hamlet, a traditional village of the Sasak tribe, showcasing ancient rice barns and houses where tribal people reside. The village holds significant cultural value for Sasak Lombok.



Next, we will explore Kuta/Tanjung Aan Beach, renowned for its white sandy beaches, some resembling grains of pepper. Lunch will be at a local restaurant in the Kuta beach area. After enjoying the beach, we will head to Sukarare Village, known for its sales and production of ikat weaving, a traditional craft of Lombok.

Our journey will then take us to Banyumulek Village, a hub for clay and pottery crafts of the Sasak tribe. The day concludes with dinner at a prepared restaurant, followed by check-in at the hotel for free time and rest.

Day 2: Trio Virgin Gilis Tour (B/L/D)

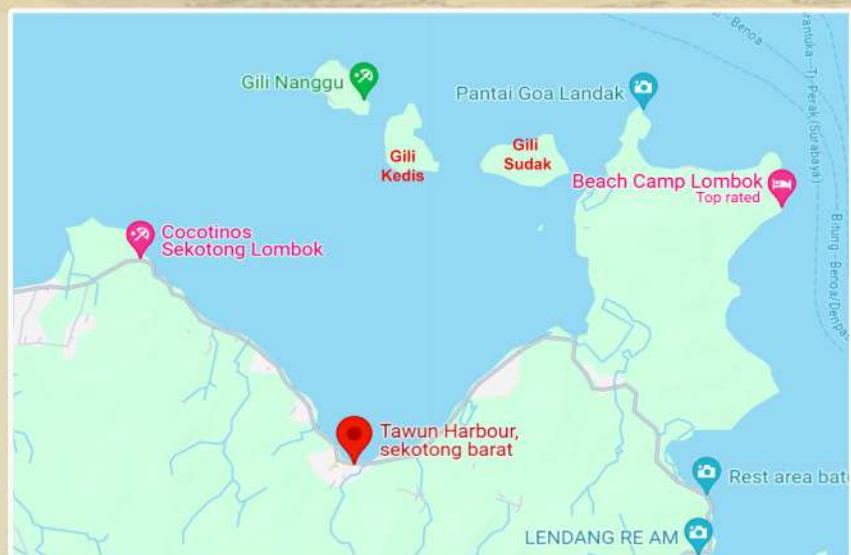

After breakfast at the hotel, the tour program commences with a visit to **Tawun harbor** to board a boat crossing to one of the Gilis. The first stop is Gili Nanggu, renowned for its stunning underwater scenery teeming with colorful fish and coral reefs, perfect for snorkeling.

Participants can enjoy snorkeling activities (at their own expense) upon arrival. Next, the journey proceeds to Gili Sudak for a traditional barbecue lunch by the beach. Following lunch, participants can unwind on the shores of Gili Sudak before heading to the third Gili, Gili Kedis, also known as Honeymoon Island.

This small island boasts soft white sands and a captivating underwater world, ideal for snorkeling and swimming. The tour concludes with a return to Tawun port, where vehicles await to transport guests to Mataram for lunch at a local restaurant. After dinner, guests will be escorted back to the hotel for free time or rest.

Day 3: Water Fall Tour (B/L/D)



After having breakfast at the hotel, we proceeded with a tour of Sendang Gile Waterfall and Tiu Kelep Waterfall, located at the base of Mount Rinjani. The scenery at this spot is truly stunning, featuring a magnificent waterfall with multiple tiers cascading through the lush greenery of the tropical forest surrounding Mount Rinjani.



Along the journey to the waterfalls, the melodious chirping of birds and the playful forest monkeys offer delightful entertainment, while the crystal-clear river flowing beside the path entices us to reach the waterfalls promptly.

If time permits, we can return to the city and visit Narmada Park, a historical site dating back to 1727, known for its mythological spring believed to possess healing properties and anti-aging effects. The day concludes with a satisfying dinner at our chosen restaurant before retiring to our hotel for a well-deserved rest.

Day 4 : Gili Trawangan Tour Monkey Forest (B.L.D)



After breakfast at the hotel, embark on the Gili Trawangan Tour program, a popular choice among tourists. Begin by visiting Malimbu Hill for stunning sea and Gili views. Proceed to the port for a boat ride to Gili Trawangan.



Once there, partake in various activities (at your own expense) like diving, snorkeling, glass bottom boat rides, marine walks, canoeing, cycling, cidomo rides, and conclude with lunch at a local restaurant. Following the day's adventures, sail back to the port where a vehicle awaits to journey to the **Pusuk Monkey Forest**.

Here, encounter numerous friendly monkeys waiting to be fed by travelers. Conclude the day with dinner at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel for leisure and rest.
